We start promptly at 8:30 am with a Safety Review...Please be on time. If you miss the Safety Review, you cannot work on the site. No exceptions, sorry. Everyone must sign a waiver and sign in prior to volunteering.



# <u>LOCATION</u>– 1794 Valency Drive, Loveland, CO 80537. Location subject to change. If you don't see anyone or have questions about where to go, call Shelly Flores (Construction Director) at: 970-227-9379.

AGE RESTRICTIONS- All volunteers must be 18 years of age or older to participate in construction related activities.

**LIABILITY WAIVER-** All volunteers must complete a Liability Waiver. Please bring completed waiver with you the morning of your build day. Waivers can be found on our website at <u>http://lovelandhabitat.org/how-to-help/volunteer.html</u>. Additional waivers will be available at the site.

**<u>SAFETY-</u>** The safety of everyone on site is our primary concern, and Loveland Habitat staff will give a Safety Review at the start of the day. All volunteers must be present for the Safety Review. If you miss the Safety Review, you cannot build on site. There are no exceptions. Please use personal protective equipment and safety gear as instructed.

**WHAT ABOUT EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS?** There's rarely a day that weather is a problem. Should we need to cancel, we will contact your group leader by email as soon as we are notified that the site is cancelled. Cancellations will be posted on our website at www.lovelandhabitat.org by 7am the morning of your build.

LUNCH BREAK There will be a lunch break at 12:00. Lunch will be provided for all volunteers

## **Build Day Reminder (Continued)**

<u>WHAT TO WEAR</u>– Dress with safety in mind and clothes that you don't mind getting dirty or stained. No shorts shorter than mid-thigh and no bare midriffs. Those not in compliance will be asked to leave. **Sturdy, closed toed shoes** are required, such as work boots or tennis shoes. Loose clothing can be dangerous when using power tools. Dress layered as weather conditions and job assignments may vary throughout the day.

<u>SUNSCREEN</u> – Your assignment may be outside, so please come prepared with sunscreen. There is sunshine during winter months, too. It is important to stay protected from the sun's direct and indirect rays.

<u>WATER</u>- It is important to stay hydrated and to take breaks. A construction cooler with Ice water/cups is available on site...please bring your own water bottle or container if you prefer.

**TOOLS** – Loveland Habitat provides all the tools and equipment. If your not sure how to use a tool, ask. If you prefer to bring your own tools, that's fine, but keep them in your possession as they are your responsibility.

**<u>LIMITATIONS/RESTRICTIONS</u>**- Please inform the construction supervisor of any limitations or restrictions that you may have. If you become uncomfortable or unable to perform a given task, alert the Construction staff and they can assign to another project.

**<u>CLEAN UP</u>**- We will stop 15 minutes prior to the end of the work day for clean up.
